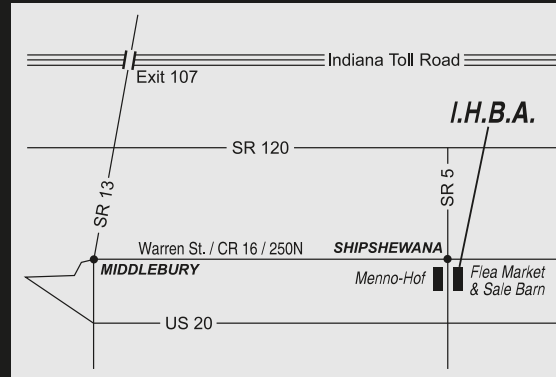

FACTS & INFO

- About the size of Maryland State, approximately 6 million people live on this small island located 750 miles southeast of Florida.
- Haiti has 7 doctors per 100,000 people, while the U.S. has 176 doctors per 100,000 people.
- Approximately 11% of the babies die at birth. 40% die before the age of 2 years.
- Average life-span is 53 years compared to the U.S. of 77.
- The top 4% of Haitians have 66% of the wealth
- There are approximately 600 people per square mile, while the U.S. has 70 people per square mile.
- One well with a hand pump often furnishes 500 people with water.
